

TORREON Mexico Mission Trip Planned for July 16-23, 2005



Are you thinking of going on the 2nd Annual TORREON Mexico Mission Trip? Here are some things to consider as you make your plans.

- Costs:
- A. Participation fee: The participation fee helps to cover travel expenses. The fee this year is \$150/person. The fee must be paid in advance.
 - B. Hotels: The trip will involve seven (7) nights at hotels. We'll stay on the U.S. side at the border on Saturday night, then spend the next 6 nights in a nice and clean hotel in Torreon, Mexico. The cost of the hotel will be about \$60-\$70 per night per room for 2 and you can have up to 4 people in a room. The more people per room, the lower the cost per person.
 - C. Food: You can estimate your personal food costs at \$4-\$7/meal. There is also a large grocery store and a Jack-in-the-Box next to the hotel. The hotel also has a restaurant.
 - D. Other than the participation fee, each person will be responsible for all other expenses including lodging and food costs.
 - E. Tourist Entry Fee: There is a possibility of a "tourist entry fee" of \$20 per person.
 - F. Passport—IT IS REQUIRED THAT YOU HAVE A PASSPORT TO GO ON THIS TRIP.
- Activities: We will be working with a rural church that has five missions located 45 minutes outside the city.
- A. VBS for 5 days—teaching, crafts, puppets, recreation, refreshments.
 - B. Evangelistic services Mon., Tues., & Wed. evenings—preaching, singing, guitar playing, door-to-door witnessing before each service.
 - C. Eyeglass ministry.
 - D. Construction—build an American-style wood-framed, peaked roof with a plywood deck and sheet metal cover. Work on the roof will be about 5-6 hours everyday. Construction workers will need heavy-duty gloves, hats, tools (such as hammers, circular saws, power drills, etc.) and lots of sunscreen.
